HOW TO USE THE DATABASE

Some Definitions for Clarity

A database is any <u>collection of interrelated information</u> stored as data on a computer system.

Databases are used to store and organize data so that it is easier to manage and access.

It is structured to facilitate storage, retrieval, and modification, of data.



Select FhGS Cemetery Records under the Public

Cemetery Records for Clear Creek, Gilpin, Jefferson, and Park Counties in Colorado.

The following database contains cemetery records for the four counties gathered by Foothills Genealogical Society members. The database contains 65 cemeteries and over 42,900 individual records.

How to use the Search Function:

You can search by using any of the search fields and then clicking on the Quick Search button. The results of the search will be displayed. If you use more than one search field, the search criteria will evaluate both fields. As such, it may be best to start with one search field and then add additional criteria to narrow the search. For example, search for cemetery, then surname.

Note the search field is a drop down. You can change the search criteria for each field. For example, you can change the search criteria for death year from 'is equal to' to 'between'. This will enable you to search a range of years.

How to View Details about a Specific Record

To view more detail about a specific record, click on the 'i' lcon on the left side of the record. This will display more details about the specific record. Click on the Back button in the Detail Page to return to the search page.

Foothills Genealogical Society Inquirer Volume 27, Number 4, Pages 99-104 Ivey Kelso McGuire Interview (Notes from Article)

Some time **during the sixteenth century a venturesome young Scotsman, Robert Kelso**, became inspired with the account of the new land of promise across the sea and decided to cast his lot with it. He set forth for the new land, leaving the village of Kelso, name many generations past for his illustrious ancestors in the highlands of Scotland. Possessing the true pioneer spirit, he became a defender of the ideals of our early Pilgrim forefathers and **fought in the Revolutionary War**. **His great grandson, Robert Sylvester Kelso**, was born in New Jersey. Robert, as a young man, **migrated with a train of covered wagons to Gallatin, Daviess County, Missouri**, where he married and after rearing a large family, his wife died.

In 1860, he answered the call of the Colorado mountains and moved with his family into the heart of them, settling at Spanish Bar in Clear Creek Canyon, now known as Idaho Springs. A few years later, he went to Linn County, Kansas, ... where he engaged in teaching school. He married his second wife ...and they returned to Colorado and Park County in 1870. He died in 1875 and was buried in the little cemetery (Horn Cemetery) near the present Highway 285 and Deer Creek.

Mr. Kelso build one of the first schoolhouses in Park County in 1871.

Chief Colorow and his band of Ute Indians were frequent visitors at the Kelso Home.

William Kelso, Ivy's only full brother, was engaged in the U.S. National Forest Service for twenty-seven years.
